**FAQ**

Let me respond to some frequently asked personal questions. How old am I? My age is the same as the house number of the rectory less one digit. If it is a speedometer, the needles points to the slowest allowed speed on a freeway; that same velocity would get a ticket in a city street. It's twice my favorite number. I'm double five years old.

When is my birthday? I was born on September 28, the feast day of St. Lorenzo Ruiz de Manila, (today that I'm writing this article), the first Filipino saint and a martyr -- a reluctant one. How is that? Well, St. Lorenzo was fleeing a sure death sentence for a crime he did not commit when he joined the Dominicans on a mission trip Japan. Upon arriving there, he and his companions were promptly taken to prison and tortured to death. St. Lorenzo could have escaped death a second time by simply renouncing his faith. This time around, he did not. He said, "I am a Catholic and wholeheartedly accept death for the Lord. Have I a thousand lives I will offer them all to God."

So why am I not named "Lorenzo"? There was no St. Lorenzo yet when I was born. St. Lorenzo was beatified only in 1981 in Manila, the first beatification to be held outside Rome. When my parents consulted the Catholic calendar, they saw a St. Wenceslaus for September 28. Like St. Lorenzo, St. Wenceslaus lived a virtuous life and died a martyr's death. My parents didn't name me after him, though, for in our place there is nasty limerick associated with the name. They feared that I may be subjected to endless teasing with such a name. So they chose the name of the following day, September 29. That is how I ended up with the name "Michael". Since I'm the first born male, my father decided to attach his name to mine as a second name. So my full name is Michael Romeo Balmaceda (mother's maiden name) Brillantes, Jr. Talk about a kilometric name.

How do I celebrate my birthday? Last night I had a lovely dinner last night with my cousins. My brother who lives in Southern California couldn't make it. Today after celebrating the morning mass and writing this article, I plan to go biking with a priest friend who is visiting from Red Bluff, California. It will be the first time that I ride a bicycle since twenty-one years ago. Bruises would be acceptable, just no broken bones. Tonight I look forward to another lovely dinner.

Thanks for the birthday greetings and gifts. I truly appreciate them.

Be reminded that next weekend is our festival. We will have the usual activities: mass, procession, coronation of the Queen, entertainment, food sales, games and raffle. Come, one and all! Last question: How old is the St. Bruno parish? It's a double nine. Next year we celebrate our centennial!

Preguntas frecuentes

Permítanme responder a algunas preguntas frecuentes personales. ¿Cuántos años tengo? Mi edad es el mismo que el número de la casa de la rectoría menos de un dígito. Es el doble de mi número favorito. Tengo dos veces cinco años de edad.

¿Cuándo es mi cumpleaños? Nací el 28 de Septiembre, el día de la fiesta de San Lorenzo Ruiz de Manila, (hoy mientras estoy escribiendo este artículo), el primer santo y mártir filipino - una renuente. ¿Cómo es eso? Pues bien, San Lorenzo fue huyendo de una sentencia de muerte segura por un crimen que no cometió, cuando se unió a los dominicanos en un viaje de la misión de Japón. Al llegar allí, él y sus compañeros fueron llevados inmediatamente a la cárcel y torturado hasta la muerte. San Lorenzo podría haber escapado de la muerte por segunda vez con sólo renunciar a su fe. Esta vez, no lo hizo. Él dijo: "Yo soy católico y acepto la muerte de todo corazón para el Señor. Mil vidas se las ofrecería todas a Dios." Entonces ¿por qué no estoy llamado "Lorenzo"? No había San Lorenzo aún cuando yo nací. San Lorenzo fue beatificado en 1981 en Manila, la primera beatificación que se celebrará fuera de Roma. Cuando mis padres consultaron el calendario católico, vieron San Wenceslao de 28 de Septiembre. Al igual que San Lorenzo, San Wenceslao vivió una vida virtuosa y murió como un mártir. Mis padres no me nombraron después de él, sin embargo, en nuestro lugar el nombre no es muy querido. Tenían miedo de que pueda ser objeto de burlas sin fin, con tal nombre. Por lo que eligió el nombre del día siguiente, 29 de Septiembre. Así es como terminé con el nombre de "Michael". Como yo soy el primer varón, mi padre decidió añadir su nombre a la mía como segundo nombre. Así que mi nombre completo es Michael Romeo Balmaceda (nombre de soltera de la madre) Brillantes, Jr. Hable acerca de un nombre kilométrico.

¿Cómo puedo celebrar mi cumpleaños? Anoche tuve una agradable cena con mis primos. Mi hermano que vive en el sur de California no pudo venir. Hoy, después de la celebración de la misa de la mañana y escribir este artículo, voy a ir en bicicleta con un amigo sacerdote que se encuentra de visita de Red Bluff, California. Será la primera vez que me monte en bicicleta desde hace veinte y un años. Esta noche tendré otra buena cena. Gracias por los saludos de cumpleaños y regalos. Yo realmente los aprecio.

Se recuerda que la próxima semana es nuestro festival. Vamos a tener las actividades habituales: misa, procesión, la coronación de la Reina, el entretenimiento, las ventas de comida, juegos y rifas. Vengan, todos y cada uno! Última pregunta: ¿Cuál es la edad de la parroquia de San Bruno? Es un doble nueve. El próximo año celebramos nuestro centenario!

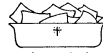
