More on Songs & Singers

Who is the patron saint of musicians and singers? That is St. Gregory the Great, whose feast we celebrated last Tuesday, September 3. St. Gregory was pope of the Church from September 590 to his death in 604. He is well known for his writings, and took himself to task in revising the Christian worship. It is him that we credit what is known as Gregorian chant, a plainchant, unaccompanied by musical instrument. Though it is not obligatory to sing it anymore at church, the Gregorian chant it is still considered as the music most suitable for worship.

What is the song of Mary? Yes, Mary sung and the song she sung is the *Magnificat*. The occasion was Mary's visit to her cousin Elizabeth who was pregnant with John the Baptist. Remember how the baby leapt in the womb of Elizabeth in joy of meeting the Savior who was in the womb of Mary? This prompted Elizabeth to shower praises to Mary, "Blessed are you among women." That is the source of our prayer "Hail Mary." Well, when Mary heard all these, she herself began to exalt God, singing the wonders of God, "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord..."

Today, September 8, is the birthday of Mary. There are a lot of Marian hymns, many of them we can recite from memory. My favorite Marian hymn is "*Hail Mary, Gentle Woman.*" Whenever I hear that song, it brings back fond memories of simple schoolchildren inside the church during the Marian month of May. They would sing with gusto and delight proclaiming their love and devotion to Mary.

Did you know that the director, guitarist and soloist at the 7PM Vigil mass got married to a member of the choir that he leads? Yes, last Saturday, August 31, I solemnized the wedding of Erick Iraheta and Patricia Rizo.

Do you know how they met? Patricia was searching for a particular song in the internet. She found the song and she found her future husband. The wedding was well attended by parishioners and visitors coming from New Jersey. I found the traditional presentation of flowers to the statue of Mary by the bride to be a very touching scene. Erick took hold of a guitar and accompanied himself singing a Marian hymn as Patricia placed the bouquet of flowers at the feet of Mary. How lovely!

On a sadder note, I'm sorry to announce the death of Gini Malaspina, a long time parishioner, organist and cantor at the 4:30PM Vigil and 8AM Sunday masses. Gini shared her musical talents to St. Bruno free of charge for 37 long years! That's what I call a lifelong dedication. Gini took to music at an early age. She learned how to play the piano and a musical instrument called auto harp. On the Sunday before her death, her daughter Alyson reported that Gini was singing as she fixed her hair.

This week begins our CCD and confirmation classes. We pray for the students, their parents and the teachers for fruitful year of learning more about the faith.

Más sobre canciones y cantantes

¿Quién es la patrona de los músicos y cantantes? Es San Gregorio Magno, cuya fiesta celebramos el pasado martes, 3 de septiembre. San Gregorio fue Papa de la Iglesia a partir de septiembre 590 hasta su muerte en 604. Es muy conocido por sus escritos, y tomó a sí mismo a la tarea de revisar el culto cristiano. A él se le da crédito a lo que se conoce como el canto gregoriano, el canto llano, acompañados por instrumentos musicales. Aunque no es obligatorio para cantar nunca más en la iglesia, el canto gregoriano sigue siendo considerado como la música más adecuada para la adoración.

¿Cuál es la canción de María? Sí, María cantaba y la canción que cantaba era la *Magnificat*. La ocasión fue la visita de María a su prima Isabel que estaba embarazada de Juan el Bautista. Recuerda cómo el bebé saltó en el vientre de Isabel en la alegría de conocer al Salvador que estaba en el vientre de María? Esto llevó a Isabel a la ducha alabanzas a María: "Bendita tú entre las mujeres". Esa es la fuente de nuestra oración "Ave María". Bueno, cuando María escuchó todo esto, ella comenzó a exaltar a Dios, cantando las maravillas de Dios, "proclama mi alma la grandeza del Señor ..."

Hoy, 8 de septiembre, es el cumpleaños de María. Hay una gran cantidad de himnos marianos, muchos de ellos se pueden recitar de memoria. Mi favorito himno Mariano es "*Dios te salve María, mujer apacible.*" Cada vez que escucho esa canción, me trae muy buenos recuerdos de los niños de la iglesia durante el mes mariano de mayo. Ellos cantaban con entusiasmo y deleite proclamando su amor y devoción a María.

¿Sabía usted que el director, guitarrista y solista de la Misa de la Vigilia de 7pm se caso con un miembro del coro que él lleva? Sí, el pasado sábado, 31 de Agosto, solemnize la boda de Erick Iraheta y Patricia Rizo.
