### Pentecost

At a gathering of 50,000 Catholic charismatics on June 1<sup>st</sup> at the Olympic stadium in Rome, Pope Francis admitted that he was not always comfortable with the way they prayed, saying, "they seemed like samba school."

Slowly, he began to appreciate how much good the movement was doing for Catholics and for the church that he himself spearheaded the Charismatic Renewal in Argentina. In concluding his talk, Pope Francis invited the crowd to come to St. Peter square for Pentecost in 2017 in celebration of the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the movement.

The Catholic Charismatic Renewal traces its origin to Duquesne University in Pittsburgh when some faculty members and students held a retreat for two days in February 1967. Following the retreat, many of the students claimed to have experienced the movement of God's Spirit. This quickly spread to other students and to other universities.

Cardinal Leo Joseph Suenens (1904-1996) one of the key architects of the Vatican II, provided a major endorsement of the movement. When he visited the US in 1972, he had a personal encounter with the Charismatics and he was immediately taken. He saw that through this movement the church would flourish like a new Pentecost taking place.

Suenens was an unlikely promoter of this movement. He was gifted with a keen intellect and cold rationality. Cardinal Levada in a talk he gave about Suenens puts it this way: "How could a cardinal whose face did not show many emotions, with a straight and immobile stature, with a grave a steady voice, finds himself at ease in a midst of a crowd that sang, danced, clapped their hands and spoke in tongues? Was it a late life conversion to fantasy and imagination in a man who had been too rational and responsible?" He answered himself, "No, rather, he perceived in this revival a return to the church of the Acts of the Apostles, a taste for scriptures, spontaneous prayer, a sense of joy, a sense of community, the stirrings of the Spirit, the proliferation of charisms. The renewal gave the legitimate role of the heart and the body back to the spiritual life of the Christians."

As we celebrate the solemn feast of the Pentecost, we pray that the Holy Spirit continue to renew the church. We pray that we entrust our plans and programs to the Holy Spirit with confidence. We pray that we abandon ourselves to God and trust in him, allowing his Spirit to guide our lives.

When the Holy Spirit leads us into uncharted territory, we pray that we will be up to the challenge and step forward, leaving behind the familiar in order to become God's own.

We have a charismatic group in the parish that meets every Monday at St. Michael's Hall. Lucy Kaloucava who used to be the leader of the Charismatic Renewal Movement in Fiji, heads the weekly gathering.

### Pentecostés

En una reunión de 50,000 católicos carismáticos en el 1° de junio en el estadio Olímpico de Roma, el Papa Francisco admitió que no siempre se sentía cómodo con la manera en que oraban, diciendo: "parecían como escuela de samba".

Poco a poco, comenzó a apreciar cuánto bien el movimiento estaba haciendo para los católicos y para la iglesia que él mismo encabezó la Renovación Carismática en Argentina. Al concluir su discurso, el Papa Francisco invitó a la multitud para llegar a Plaza San Pedro en Pentecostés en el año 2017 en la celebración del 50º aniversario del movimiento.

\*\*\*

La Renovación Carismática Católica tiene su origen en la Universidad de Duquesne en Pittsburgh, cuando algunos miembros de la facultad y los estudiantes realizaron un retiro durante dos días en febrero de 1967. Tras la retirada, muchos de los estudiantes afirmaron haber experimentado el movimiento del Espíritu de Dios. Esto se extendió rápidamente a otros estudiantes y para otras universidades.

Cardenal Joseph Leo Suenens (1904-1996) uno de los principales arquitectos del Vaticano II, un importante respaldo del movimiento. Cuando visitó los Estados Unidos en 1972, tuvo un encuentro personal con los carismáticos y fue llevado de inmediato. Vio que a través de este movimiento la iglesia florecería como si fuera un Nuevo Pentecostés.

Suenens era un promotor poco probable de este movimiento. Estaba dotado de un agudo intelecto y racionalidad fría. El cardenal Levada en una charla que dio sobre Suenens lo pone de esta manera: "¿Cómo puede un cardenal cuyo rostro no mostró muchas emociones, con una estatura recta e inmóvil, con una grave voz firme, se encuentra a gusto en un medio de una multitud que cantaban, bailaban, aplaudían y hablaban en lenguas? ¿Fue una conversión final de la vida a la fantasía y la imaginación en un hombre que había sido demasiado racional y responsable "Él respondió a sí mismo : "No, más bien, él percibe en este renacimiento de un retorno a la Iglesia de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, una probada de las Escrituras, la oración espontánea, una sensación de alegría, un sentido de comunidad, el despertar del Espíritu, la proliferación de los carismas. La renovación dio el papel legítimo del corazón y al cuerpo le regreso la vida espiritual de los cristianos".

Al celebrar la fiesta solemne de Pentecostés, oramos para que el Espíritu Santo continúe renovando la iglesia. Oremos para que le confiemos nuestros planes al Espíritu Santo con confianza. Pedimos a Dios que nos abandonemos a Dios y confiemos en él, permitiendo que su Espíritu guie nuestras vidas.

Cuando el Espíritu Santo nos lleva a un terreno desconocido, oremos para que estemos a la altura y demos un paso adelante, dejando atrás lo familiar con el fin de convertirnos en el propio Dios.

Tenemos un grupo carismático en la parroquia que se reúne todos los lunes en el Salón de San Miguel. Lucy Kaloucava quien solía ser el líder del Movimiento de Renovación Carismática en Fiji, encabeza la reunión semanal.

"Señor, envía tu Espíritu y renueva la faz de la tierra!"

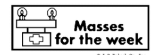
