Parish Mission Talks

The scheduled series of Parish Mission Talks this July is designed to bring together parishioners in leadership functions and others who are actively involved in the church in order to understand more what it means to be a parish and clarify directions. Likewise, the event provides the opportunity for people to know more each other; put face and organization together, so to speak. For there is no question that we have organizations and activities galore at St. Bruno's but who belong to which group and what exactly are the groups doing are not exactly clear.

The first mission talk was given by Fr. Eamonn last Tuesday to the English-speaking group. He stressed the importance of familiarity with the Vatican II documents and the Catechism of the Catholic Church. These two books say a lot about the meaning and implications of being a church. He spoke of how globalization and secularization pose a threat to religion and Christianity. He clarified that that the church does not have a mission but that by its very nature the church is missionary and everyone is called to carry the light of Christ to all. In the small group discussion (SGD) that followed, handouts were given about the "parish" as "stable community of the faithful" and of the importance of the family in the transmission and nurture of faith. Then group reports were given on how these apply to St. Bruno parish. The night was concluded with a prayer. Everyone I asked said it was a very enriching gathering. Next Tuesday, the same talk will be given to the Spanish-speaking community.

- Who is the president of Nicaragua?
- Where is the epicenter of the recent earthquake that hit Southern Mexico and Guatemala?
- It is the smallest kingdom on earth.
- The country that was occupied by Spain for 400 years and by US for 40 years.

Platicas Misioneras de la Parroquia

La series programada de las Platicas Misioneras este mes de Julio está diseñado para reunir a los feligreses en las funciones de liderazgo y otras personas que participan activamente en la iglesia con el fin de comprender mejor lo que significa ser una parroquia y aclarar las direcciones. Asimismo, el evento ofrece la oportunidad para que la gente se conozca más entre sí; poner la cara y la organización en conjunto, por así decirlo. Porque no hay duda de que tenemos las organizaciones y actividades en abundancia en San Bruno, pero quien pertenecen a cada grupo y cuáles son exactamente los grupos no estamos del todo claro.

La primera platica Misionera fue dada por el Padre Eamonn el martes pasado al grupo de Inglés. Hizo hincapié en la importancia de la familiaridad con los documentos del Concilio Vaticano II y el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica. Estos dos libros dicen mucho sobre el significado y las implicaciones de ser una iglesia. Habló de cómo la globalización y la secularización son una amenaza para la religión y el cristianismo. Aclaró que la Iglesia no tiene una misión, pero que por su propia naturaleza la Iglesia es misionera y todo el mundo está llamado a llevar la luz de Cristo a todos. En la discusión en grupos pequeños, se les dio folletos acerca de la "parroquia" como "comunidad estable de los fieles", y de la importancia de la familia en la transmisión y la crianza de la fe. Luego informes de los grupos se les dio en cómo se aplican a San Bruno como iglesia. La noche concluyó con una oración. Todo el mundo le pregunté dijo que fue una reunión muy enriquecedora. El próximo martes, la misma platica será impartida a la comunidad de habla hispana.

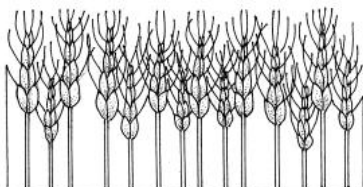
