Oaxaca

Oaxaca is a state in the southern part of Mexico. It is a beautiful land of mountains and valleys with a large population of Zapotec and Mixtec Indians. I went there primarily to attend the Guelaguetza festival. This is an annual cultural event that brings together the indigenous communities of Oaxaca to present their culture by way of dances, music, dress and food. Though I missed it as I got confused with the time, I learned a lot and came back satisfied.

I reached the capital, also named Oaxaca, after a 7-hour ride from Mexico City via the comfortable deluxe ADO (Autobus del Oriente) bus service. My hotel was a short hop from the bus terminal and after quickly settling in, I decided to check out the downtown or "el centro" as is known locally.

The cathedral is the hub of human activity. All around it and especially up front in the Parque Alameda there are sidewalk vendors, peddlers of handicraft, performers, artists, and tourists. From outside, the cathedral is quite impressive. The central panel of the façade depicts the assumption of the Virgin which by the way is celebrated this Friday and is a day of obligation. The interior, however, is lackluster as it was plundered during the Wars of Reform.

A few blocks away to the west is the Church of San Felipe Neri with ornate decorations. Further to the west is the Basilica de Soledad. When I walked down or more precisely hobbled (due to gout attack) down the steps, I noticed a troupe rehearsing an indigenous dance in the upper plaza. Noontime mass was about to begin when I got there so I stayed and that's how I missed the Guelaguetza festival.

According to the tour guide in Santo Domingo Church, there are 29 churches in Oaxaca but none can equal the splendor of the interior of this church. It took the Dominican friars 100 years to build it. It's like the whole interior glow in resplendent gold.

Back at the Cathedral, I enjoyed a mug of chocolate seated before an outdoor table observing people passing by, the vendors, the street performers and I also had a good view of the church towers. As the sun dipped in the west it bathed the towers in golden hue. That with the Zapotec man strumming a pretty worn-out guitar and the couple to the table on my right enjoying bowls of mole made the whole scenery so fantastic. And I thought, "God is here."

After the earthquake there was fire but the Lord was not in the fire. After the fire there was a tiny whispering sound." - 1 Kings 11-13a

God is here for us at all times, from a tiny whispering sound to a mighty storm.

Oaxaca

Oaxaca es un estado en la parte sur de México. Es una hermosa tierra de montañas y valles, con una gran población de indios zapotecas y mixtecas. Fui allí principalmente para asistir al festival de la Guelaguetza. Este es un evento cultural anual que reúne a las comunidades indígenas de Oaxaca para presentar su cultura a través de danzas, música, vestimenta y alimentos. Aunque me lo perdí porque me confundi con la hora, he aprendido mucho y volví satisfecho.

Llegué a la capital, también llamada Oaxaca, después de un viaje de 7 horas desde la Ciudad de México a través del ADO de lujo (Autobus del Oriente) servicio de autobús. Mi hotel estaba cerca de la terminal de autobuses y después de establecerme rápidamente, decidí ir a la centro de la ciudad o "el centro", como se conoce localmente.

La catedral está en el centro de la actividad humana. Todo a su alrededor y sobre todo en la delantera en el Parque Alameda hay vendedores ambulantes, vendedores de artesanías, artistas, artistas y turistas. Desde fuera, la catedral es bastante impresionante. El panel central de la fachada representa la asunción de la Virgen, que por cierto se celebra este viernes y es un día de obligación. El interior, sin embargo, es mediocre, ya que fue saqueada durante la Guerra de Reforma.

A pocas cuadras al oeste se encuentra la Iglesia de San Felipe Neri con decoraciones ornamentales. Más al oeste se encuentra la Basílica de la Soledad. Cuando bajé cojeando (debido al ataque degota) por las escaleras, me di cuenta de una compañía ensayando una danza indígena en la plaza superior. La Misa del Mediodía estaba por comenzar cuando llegué allí así que me quedé y así es como me perdí el festival Guelaguetza. De acuerdo con la guía de turismo en la iglesia de Santo Domingo, hay 29 iglesias en Oaxaca pero ninguno puede igualar el esplendor del interior de esta iglesia. Tomó a los frailes dominicanos 100 años para construirlo. Es como si todo el resplandor interior en oro resplandeciente.

De vuelta en la Catedral, disfruté de una taza de chocolate sentado en una mesa al aire libre observando a la gente que pasaba, los vendedores, los artistas de la calle y también tuve una buena vista de las torres de la iglesia. A medida que el sol se ponía en el oeste que bañaba las torres en tono dorado. Que con el hombre zapoteca rasgueando una guitarra muy desgastado y la pareja de la mesa a mi derecha disfrutando de platos de mole hizo todo el paisaje tan fantástico. Y yo pensé: "Dios está aquí."




PAPAL VISIT TO SOUTH KOREA
